

NOVALES-UDIAS PROJECT – SITUATED IN PROVEN MINING DISTRICT






- San Jose (12km²) Mining Licence hosting former producing San Jose zinc mine
- Buenahora (41km²) Exploration Licence hosting +60 historical (mostly artisanal) workings
- Defined and metallurgically simple MVT zinc sulfide deposit along a 9km trend
- Shallow mineralisation (170-240m depth), hosted by dolostone, and consists of stacked flat-lying elongated ore lenses, with good continuity
- High grades, with zinc strongly dominant over lead (c. 10% Zn+Pb).
- Simple mineralogy (sphalerite), easy processing, high quality concentrate
- No exploration for ~30yrs until project acquired by Variscan
- 8km NW of the world-class historic Reocin zinc deposit (62 Mt @ 9.7% Zn, 1% Pb).
- Proximity to Glencore's San Juan de Nieva zinc smelter (2nd largest globally)





SAN JOSE MINE

- Former high-grade zinc producing mine; ceased production in late 1990s due to prevailing metal prices
- Excellent condition: underground development extends over a linear length of c. 2.5km
- Links to much larger historical Udias zinc mine complex (> 3.5 km of linear length, within permit area)
- Comprehensive 3D hi-resolution laser topographic survey of stopes and ore pasess & development
- 3x underground drilling campaigns conducted to date totaling 177 holes for $\sim 4,806$ m
- Ongoing undergound drilling flexible, efficient & cost-effective drilling using own portable rig
- 3x step-out surface drill-holes from the San Jose Mine indicate growth potential; followup drilling planned for CY24 with permit applications submitted
- Expanded our extensive & valuable database of 1,105 drillholes for 94,808 m.
- Estimated replacement value of AUD\$~22m¹




JORC MINERAL RESOURCE ESTIMATE FOR SAN JOSE BY DEPOSIT







JORC MINERAL RESOURCE ESTIMATE CATEGORIES - 3D ORIENTATED VIEW




- Resources in the Indicated category represent 45% of the Mineral Resource Estimate

- Significant potential for grade and tonnage increases with infill drilling






JORC MINERAL RESOURCE ESTIMATE CATEGORIES - PLAN VIEW







MINERAL RESOURCE ESTIMATE – GRADE TONNAGE, BY ZN CUT-OFF GRADE





- Exploration Target indicates the potential scale and grade of mineralization
- 3x 6x potential growth increase to size of MRE
- Exploration Target is concentrated around the MRE deposits and over the same strike length.
- These areas are well understood by Variscan
 → a de-risked opportunity
- Variscan's planned field work for CY 2024 will include drilling over the extent of the Exploration Target.
- The new Exploration Target for the San Jose Mine is supplemental to the JORC compliant Exploration Target over the larger Novales-Udias Project published by Variscan in Q3 2022 which remains extant.



The potential quantity and grade of this exploration target is conceptual in nature, there is currently insufficient exploration completed to support a mineral resource of this size and it is uncertain whether continued exploration will result in the estimation of a Mineral Resource. The Exploration Target has been prepared in accordance with the JORC Code (2012)



GRADE CURVE OF REPORTED MINERAL RESOURCES FOR GLOBAL ZINC SULPHIDE DEPOSITS





Grade Curve of ASX Zinc Sulphide Deposits






MINERAL RESOURCE ESTIMATE - BENCHMARKING TONNAGE / GRADE

SHALLOW DEPOSIT - GRADE & DEPTH OF ZINC SULPHIDE MINERALIZATION








SAN JOSE MINE - PROVEN HIGH-GRADE WITH SIMPLE METALLURGY












INDICATIVE TIMELINE OF KEY DELIVERABLES
